The company started out as a dynamic collective of actors, teachers, nature interpreters, composers, and writers, and has since evolved into an award-winning non-for-profit charitable society. We offer curriculum-based touring shows, artist-in residency programs, a mobile puppet theatre, commissioned works for zoos, science centres and museums, presentations for organizations nation-wide and custom field trips to our fabulous facility, Evergreen Community SPACES.





By integrating science with a variety of theatrical media, including, but not limited to, drama, storytelling, movement, puppetry, musical theatre and mask, Evergreen strives to create engaging productions that are as informative as they are entertaining. The goal is to inspire scientific literacy and enthusiasm through the arts, as well as to empower audiences with accessible and positive choices to keep the world around them forever green.

Our Mission

To create, facilitate and empower youth by fostering meaningful curriculumbased theatrical programming that explores and inspires; innovation, stewardship and sustainability through the intersection of education, art, science and community.

Evergreen Theatre values a balanced approach to interpretive theatre whereby the elements of entertainment and education are given equal attention and importance. We focus on the family audience through the use of song, dance, big expressive characters, puppetry, and larger than life costumes and sets. Evergreen strives to produce shows and residencies that address current scientific issues and contain an awareness of popular culture and modern sensibilities. All artistic choices (script, costumes, character development choices) follow a "fact-to-fiction" approach.





Touring Shows

Evergreen performs a 45 minute signature show with 2 professional actors in elementary schools. Our theatrical performances engage children from Grades K-6, with opportunities for students to perform in the show. Shows feature curriculum-based scripts, exciting sets, props, and costumes - and popular music based on hits that kids and teachers love. All with our signature environmental and science education themes!

Following the show, our Evergreen artists ask related questions about the material presented, reinforcing the topics learned in the production.



Artist-in-Residency



Using inquiry-based learning, our professional artists challenge students to discover meaning and relevance to curriculum-linked topics pertinent to natural, scientific and sustainability-oriented issues. Since the program focuses on facilitating the students and staff in the creation of an original, custom-made show, we may also explore topics in social studies, culture and heritage, and global citizenship, as per the school's request. Our methods of exploration include performance creation, movement, puppetry/mask, playwriting, music, and physical theatre.

Our students 99 loved the experience! They 66 got to shine!



Facilitating the development of both critical and creative thinking as well as problem solving, the artists support a process where the students participate in the creation of an original performance that raises scientific and social awareness and thus empower youth to take part in making positive choices. Through the arts we create a memorable experience, building the base for a lifelong investment in, and commitment to, science and the natural world.

She has also made appearances in various television projects. In 2015, Snizhana became involved in the international theatre project "Salt," which she continues to contribute to. Recognizing her passion for nurturing young talent, she opened her own dance and theatre school for children aged 2 to 18, accumulating 10 years of experience working with children.
